The Rooks County Free Fair Old-Timers' Livestock Judging Contest should provide fun for some of the (older??) judges in the area. This contest is being sponsored by the Rooks County Free Fair, the Rooks County 4-H Council, and the Palco, Plainville, and Stockton FFA chapters.

Rules of the Contest

1. Date of Contest: Friday, August 14, 2009.
2. Registration from 7:30 - 8:30 a.m.

3. Classes to be judged will consist of eight classes of the following: Beef, Swine, and Sheep.
4. All participants will be required to judge with designated group.
5. Age Categories (age figured as of time of contest):

Division I 18 years through 29 years of age

Division II 30 years of age and over

1. **Open to any Kansas commercial beef producer.** (Registered animals not eligible for this show.)
2. All animals must be exhibited in pasture condition. **Absolutely no fitting will be allowed.** The "Livestock Health Requirements" outlined in this book also apply to the Super Cow/Calf Show entrants. **Absolutely no bull calves allowed.**
3. One cow/calf pair entry per contestant.
4. An entry will consist of one cow and her natural calf.
5. Age of cow and birth date of calf must be known.
6. All cows and calves will be weighed upon arrival at the Rooks County Free Fair. These animals will be housed and shown in the Show Arena.
7. All pairs must be unloaded and processed by 9:00 a.m. on Friday, Aug. 14. Judging will begin at 1:00 p.m., and animals will be released at 6:00 p.m.
8. Animals will be judged on type, structure, muscling, natural fleshing, soundness of udder, eyes, feet, legs. The calf at side will be evaluated on the same criteria.
9. Cow weight and the calf's projected 205-day adjusted weight will be given to the evaluators at the time of judging.
10. A two-judge system will be used. Each judge will score each cow and calf independently, and the total score of both judges will be used to rank the pairs in each division.
11. **ENTRY DEADLINE IS AUG. 3.** Entries should be submitted to David Pieper on the form at the bottom of the page.
12. If entries are sufficient, the classes will also be divided by age of dam.
13. Total payout will be determined by the number of entries.

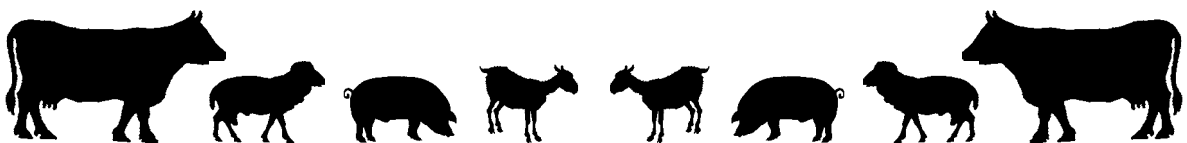

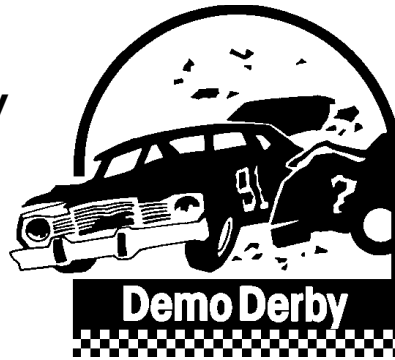

Eagle Radio Pedal Pull Rules

Contestants Must:

1. Be able to pedal the tractor without assistance.
2. Wear comfortable walking shoes or tennis shoes at all times—**no thongs or sandals**. Shoes must be tied at all times.
3. Be registered by a parent or guardian prior to the beginning of the pull of the first class.

Operation of the Pull:

4. Track will be provided and marked by the operator.
5. Only one contestant at a time and pull officials will be allowed within 25 feet of the track. Pictures by the parent may be taken only at the time of the child's pull.
6. Pedal tractor and sled will be provided by the owner/operator for all the contestants.
7. There will be 9 classes of contestants, ages 4 to 12 years. **Contestants cannot be 13 years old on or**

before the first Sunday of the State Fair pull in September.

8. Sanctioned operator will provide the first- and second-place winners of each class with a voucher, which entitles them to pull at the State Fair.
9. The pulling tractor must stay between the lines of the pulling lane or on the pulling lane at all times. **If the front wheels go off the track, the pull is over and the distance measured.**
10. Any time the forward movement of the tractor stops, the pull is over and the distance measured. **This includes foot slipping off the pedal.**
11. In case of a tie, there will be a pull-off to determine the winner.
12. **The judge's decision will be final for all pulls.**
