2. Exhibitors must have the original registration certificate on each animal available for inspection at the show.

Class B – Jersey                        Class E – Milking  
Class C – Guernsey                      Shorthorn
4. One breed will not be judged against another breed. Breed must be stated on entry form.
5. **A copy of health papers must be signed by a licensed vet and accompany entry.**

Lot 6 — Heifer, 1 year old and under 18 months

Lot 7 — Heifer, 4 months and under 1 year

Lot 21 — Best of 3 females (any age, owned by exhibitor and must have been shown in their respective single-entry lots)

Lot 22 — Dam and daughter (daughter can be of any age but produce of 1 cow; both must be shown in individual lots)

Lot 3 — 8 months to 12 months (not in milk or previously freshened)  
Lot 4 — 12 months to 24 months (not in milk or previously freshened)

1. The date for computing age will be the day of judging.
2. This show will be open to all exhibitors. Breeds showing will be as follows:

Class H – Alpine                      Class L – Toggenburg  
Class I – Lamancha                  Class M – Oberhasli  
Class J – Nubian                      Class N – Other Breeds  
Class K – Saanen

All other breeds will be shown as one breed.

3. Specify breed on entry form. Goats from breeds with fewer than 5 entries will compete together.
4. **A copy of health papers signed by a licensed vet must accompany entry.**
5. All goats must be identified with an official USDA Premise I.D. tag or registration tattoo.
