DIVISION 4 — SHEEP

Enter: Monday, August 10 (8:00 a.m. to noon)

Judging: Tuesday, August 11 (5:00 p.m.)

Release: Wednesday, August 12 (8:00 p.m.)

1. Sheep must be owned by exhibitor or member of immediate family 30 days prior to show.
2. Age in all lots will be determined from a base date of Jan. 1.
3. Market lambs with testicles will be disqualified from competition.
4. Recognized breeds of sheep will be as follows:

Class A – Shropshire	Class F – Suffolk
Class B – Southdown	Class G – Montadale
Class C – Hampshire	Classes H, I, J – Other
Class D – Corriedale	Breeds
Class E – Dorset	
5. Specify breed on entry form.
6. Each breed of breeding animals will be shown separately.
7. All sheep (Breeding and Market) must be free of any signs of “sore mouth,” active fungal infection (ringworm), including club lamb fungus, and other contagious disease. All sheep must be identified with an official USDA premise ID tag. If an exhibitor’s animal is not tagged by fair time, that animal will not be able to participate in the 4-H Show or Livestock Sale. Sheep must be inspected by the Official Fair Veterinarian prior to unloading. Healthy lambs hauled with lambs having fungal infection may not unload.
8. Market lambs must be born after Jan. 1.
9. No paint above the hock.
10. **A copy of health papers signed by a licensed vet must accompany all Open Class sheep.**
11. All sheep (Breeding and Market) must be “slick shorn” with an equal amount of wool above the knee and hock (head excluded) prior to inspection and unloading. A maximum of 0.2 inch of wool is permitted.
12. Ewe lambs shown in the 4-H Market Show **cannot** be shown in the Open Class Breeding Show.

BREEDING CLASSES – CLASSES A-J

CLASS (specify A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I, or J)

Lot 1 — Ram lamb, spring

Lot 2 — Ram lamb, fall

Lot 3 — Ram, 1 year and under 2

Lot 4 — Pair of ram lambs

Lot 5 — Pair of yearling rams

Lot 6 — Ewe lamb, spring

Lot 7 — Ewe lamb, fall

Lot 8 — Yearling ewe

Lot 9 — Ewe, 2 years and older

Lot 10 — Pair of ewe lambs

Lot 11 — Pair of yearling ewes

Lot 12 — Pair of lambs (see “Lots Defined”)

Lot 13 — Flock (see “Lots Defined”)

Lot 14 — Get-of-sire (see “Lots Defined”)

LOTS DEFINED

Pair of Lambs: Either or both sexes (ewe or ram), owned by exhibitor, both get-of-same-sire (spring or fall)

Flock: 1 ram, under 2 years; 2 yearling ewes; 2 ewe lambs, all owned and shown by exhibitor

Get-of-Sire: 4 lambs, either sex, get-of-1-sire

AWARDS

First place: \$10.00 and Ribbon

Second place: \$5.00 and Ribbon

Third place: \$3.00 and Ribbon

Breed Champion: \$10.00 and Ribbon

Breed Reserve Champion: \$7.00 and Ribbon

MARKET LAMB CLASS – CLASS M

1. The top 5 overall Market Lambs in the Rooks County 4-H and FFA show will be automatically entered. All other Open Class Market Lambs need to enter on an Open Class Livestock Entry Form.
2. Weigh on Monday from 8:00 a.m.-noon; release on Wednesday at 8:00 p.m. The show will be after the 4-H show Tuesday at 5:00 p.m.
3. 4-H Market Lambs that aren’t in the top 5 may not enter Open Class.

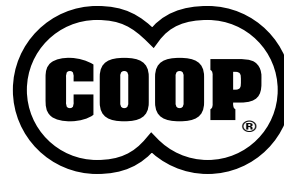
