

DIVISION 5 — SWINE

Superintendent: Chris Kriley

Enter: Tuesday, August 11 (8:00 a.m. to noon)  
Judging: Wednesday, August 12 (8:00 a.m., following 4-H Show)  
Release: Thursday, August 13 (noon)

1. Swine must be owned by the exhibitor or member of immediate family. Registration papers must be exhibited upon request of Superintendent or judges.
2. The base dates for determining age of hogs are March 1 and Sept. 1.
3. Health requirements: Out-of-state swine must comply with uniform methods and rules for interstate movement. Health certificate must accompany entry form. These health requirements must be met before swine will be allowed to unload at the fairgrounds.
4. Health papers may be required for other diseases before entering and unloading of livestock should the Fair Board feel that it is necessary. Exhibitors that have entries made by the deadline will be notified of any testing requirements.
5. All pens and alleys adjoining must be cleaned before 10:00 a.m. each day and refuse disposed of as the Superintendent may direct. Pens and alleys must be kept clean throughout the day.
6. See health requirements in "Rules and Regulations."

1. The top 5 blue-ribbon hogs in the Rooks County 4-H show will automatically be entered. All other Open Class hogs need to enter on an Open Class Livestock Entry Form.
2. 4-H Market Hogs that are not in the top 5 may not enter Open Class.
3. Enter Tuesday morning — weigh-in from 7:00 a.m.-10:30 a.m. The show will be after the 4-H show; release Thursday at noon.
4. Both barrows and gilts may be shown in this class.
