

DIVISION 6 — POULTRY

Superintendents: Randy Hrabe, Diane Hrabe

1. Singles cannot compete with pens, and specimens entered in pens cannot compete with singles, nor can old singles or pens compete with young singles or pens.
2. Each exhibitor must indicate breed of poultry on the entry tag.
3. No exhibitor may show more than 4 breeds of poultry.
4. An exhibitor is limited to no more than 1 entry per lot.
5. Entries must be in place by 5:00 p.m. Monday, entry day.
6. Release time for entries is 1:00 p.m. on Saturday.
7. A competent judge will be present to judge the fowls by the comparison method and according to the rules of the American Poultry Association. Fowls on display are not to be handled by anyone, either exhibitor or visitor, except by officers of the Poultry Department or by their consent.
8. Any pullet or cockerel in a Pen may not be entered in the Single classes.
9. Definitions: Fowls must be exhibited as Cock (over 1 year); Cockerel (under 1 year); Hen (over 1 year); Pullet (under 1 year); Old Pen (over 1 year); or Young Pen (under 1 year). A Pen consists of 2 females and 1 male.

11. Health Requirements—all poultry, except waterfowl, must show proof that they are pullorum-typhoid clean at time of entry by one of the following methods:
 - A. Originate from a U.S. pullorum-typhoid clean flock as evidenced by an official VS form 9-3 certifying that all birds in the flock over 4 months of age have had a negative test for pullorum-typhoid within the past year.
 - B. Present evidence that the entries (a) were purchased from a U.S. pullorum-typhoid clean source, and (b) are either the only poultry on the premises of the owner or have been physically separated (e.g., housed in separate houses) from other flocks on the premises.
 - C. Present an official form 9-2 signed by an official blood-testing agent showing that the entries have had a negative result from an official pullorum-typhoid test conducted within 90 days prior to the exhibition. The sealed legband numbers of the bird(s) must appear on the form.
 - D. Entries not qualifying under A, B, or C must indicate a negative test for pullorum-typhoid diseases at the time of entry.
12. **Indicate breed on entry form.**
