1. Read "General Rules and Regulations."
2. The Dog Obedience Competition will be Monday, August 9, immediately following the 4-H Show.
3. Dogs must be cleaned and groomed for show.
4. Lots are to be judged in the order listed below.
5. Abuse of a dog will result in disqualification.
6. No baiting allowed.
7. Dog must be pre-entered on entry form in back of this book; must be pre-entered by noon Monday, August 9. A copy of health papers must be signed by a licensed vet and accompany entry.
8. Champion and Reserve Champion ribbons will be given to the two top qualifying scores.
9. Enter only one obedience class with a dog.
10. Maximum entry: 3 per handler, 1 dog per obedience class.
11. **Dogs must remain on a leash on Fairgrounds unless being shown in the arena.**
